SCHOOL OF FRONTIER MISSIONS

History bears witness to the courage of thousands of men and women who have counted the cost and set out to obey Jesus' command to make disciples of the nations. The examples of such men and women as William Carey, Hudson Taylor, Amy Carmichael, and the Moravians stand as an encouragement to us all as we look at a world that is still very much in need of the transforming gospel of Jesus Christ.

It is one thing to desire to be a light to the nations; it is another to know how to go about doing that. The School of Frontier Missions (SoFM) is a course designed to equip Christians to live and work amongst those forgotten people groups who live in the frontiers, those regions that have had little or no exposure to the message of God's grace in Christ Jesus.

The SoFM consists of a 3 month lecture phase at The Seamill Centre. Available after the lecture phase is a 2 year field placement as part of an existing team.

THE LECTURE PHASE

The lecture phase is an intensive 3 month course that will provide you with the knowledge and life-skills needed to develop into an effective cross-cultural missionary. Some of the issues covered are:

- * Biblical Basis and History of Missions
- * Understanding Worldview and Culture
- * Language Acquisition
- * Church Planting Principles and Methods
- * Intercession and Strategic Prayer
- * Developing a Healthy Support Base (Financial and Prayer)
- * Cross-Cultural Adaptation
- * Team Dynamics and Leadership
- * Preparing for the Next Step

THE FIELD PLACEMENT

The Field Placement is an opportunity which lasts 2 years. These years should be seen as your first step towards a long and fruitful ministry. Our teaching reflects this long-term commitment, and is designed to help you make the life changes associated with overseas work.

At The Seamill Centre we have links with missions teams all over the world and we will aim to facilitate your placement into the country where you feel led. If you know that you want to be involved in missions but are unsure where to go, we will pray with you and present different options. YWAM Scotland has also adopted 8 specific unreached people groups that we strategically minister to. Please contact us for more information.

The prerequisite for taking this course is the completion of a Discipleship Training School (DTS)* and a passion to know God and make Him known to those who have never heard the Gospel. (*Exceptions considered, although such candidates would not qualify for long-term work with YWAM until having done a DTS.)

The SOFM is run at the Seamill Centre, which is situated on the beautiful west coast of Scotland. The Seamill Centre is a Youth With A Mission (YWAM) training centre, dedicated to equipping and releasing missionaries. We are a community of people that is passionate to know God deeply and to make Him known to the ends of the earth.
